Joint and Common OASIS: Options

Two Node Options

- **Look and Feel**
 - Current nodes remain.
 - Similar navigation scheme applied
 - Application
 - Documentation
 - Similar look
 - Button location
 - Data layout
- **Linked OASIS Node**
 - Current nodes remain
 - Submit PJM and Midwest ISO reservations on either node



Joint and Common OASIS: Options

Single Node Options

Reduces maintenance to single node

- **1 Node, 2 Providers**
 - 1 node
 - Identical look and feel
- **Virtual Provider**
 - 1 node
 - Identical look and feel
 - 1 reservation
- **Common OASIS Portal**
 - 1 node
 - Identical look and feel
 - linked reservations
