Vision and Scope

➤ Business Requirements

- Develop data sharing and notification requirements for outage information
- Develop protocols and procedures for coordination outages that affect one or more reciprocal entities
- Establish protocols for operating practices during outage operations that affect one or more reciprocal entity

➤ Scope

- To develop an outage coordination agreement to be included in the current Seams operating agreements between the reciprocal entities
- Task Force sunset date upon completion

Outage Coordination

Benefits of the Outage Coordination Process Agreement

➤ Formalizes and Expands upon current Seams Outage Coordination

- Identifies parties responsible for Communication
 - Advanced/Planned
 - Real-Time / Current Operating Day
- Specifies information exchange requirements
 - Date Exchange
 - Phone and Email Exchange
 - Daily and Weekly Coordination Meetings
- Defines Timeline for Advanced Notification of Outages
- Operating Guide Development and Coordination
- Outage Cancellation and Conflicting Request Resolution
- Provides Contact Information
- Utilizes a Interregional Coordination Facility List
