Scope

- October 31, 2005
 - A central location where both Midwest ISO and PJM ramp reservations and viewers can be accessed
 - Midwest ISO and PJM will make system changes to display ramp data in a common area
- June 1, 2007
 - One web site to view both ramps
 - Two phase approach
 - Hourly ramp data for up to 48 hours
 - Frequency of updates for hourly data is more important than providing long-term data

Proposed Approach



- PJM and Midwest ISO will exchange ramp data in real-time.
- Phase 1: Midwest ISO & PJM data on Midwest ISO's ramp viewer (separate tabs).
- Phase 2: Midwest ISO & PJM ramp data on independent ramp viewer on Joint and Common Market website: www.miso-pjm.com

Advantages



- Leveraging existing technology and skill sets to minimize costs.
- Builds a foundation to support the 2008 initiative to view and reserve ramp in both RTOs simultaneously.
- Provides tools so that imports and exports of energy between the RTOs can be done more effectively.
